The goals of the program are many, including strengthening parent-child attachment, building a supportive group where isolated people can feel comfortable, and creating opportunities for different generations to interact.

These groups are offered by Partners for Children in the fall, winter and spring of each year. Each offering involves partnerships with rotating agencies and NGOs, and locations vary.
